 Learn about careers Check out various jobs and industries on myfuture to see what different careers are like. Watch videos of people talking about their jobs. Suggest that they talk to family members or friends who are working in jobs that interest them, to find out about different jobs.
 Get ready for job applications Use templates and tips on myfuture to help them write resumes and cove letters. Encourage them to talk to local employers about doing work experience at a workplace, to get a feel for their chosen career.
 General support Talk to your child about their feelings and plans for the future. Keep up-to-date with the resources and support available to your child. Offer emotional support and reassurance as your child navigates this
