Tertiary or Independent Student

As part of the *Learning for Life* program, The Smith Family partners with a tertiary or independent student.

An independent student is a student who is:

- a tertiary student, or
- a senior secondary student (i.e. in year 11, 12 or 13) who is living independently or in supported accommodation,

and, who

- agrees to take responsibility for the *Learning for Life* Partnership Agreement, and
- agrees to be the point of contact for The Smith Family.
