Learning Outcome Through reflecting on their Work Inspiration activities students can identify the Key Learning Points (KLPs) from their Work Inspiration experience which they can include in their thank you letter to the Host Employer/Industry. These KLPs will assist them in future career planning.

Outline To include:

- What you learnt – Key Learning Points
- Words that had an impact
- How did Work Inspiration challenge or confirm your intended pathway
- Connect skills to school subjects
- Connect your skills learned outside the classroom to school or in the workplace
- Action to be taken.

Employers – to use to inform program preparation

Timing Within one week after completion of the Work Inspiration program and the Reflection activity (at the workplace). This activity will help students to identify the Key Learning Points for them from Work Inspiration that they can include in their thank you letter to the Work Inspiration Host Employer or Industry.

Note: Parts of this can be completed as a peer/group activity but this would be dependent on the teacher facilitating the activity.

Procedure The Reflection Worksheet (and Resource 16, "Thank you letter to employer" Template) should be provided to students by the organising teacher on return from Work Inspiration.

The students should follow the instructions as indicated by the teacher on the top of the "Thank you letter to employer" Template.

This activity can be used to inform personal pathway plans.
