Year 8 students unleash their creativity

One March morning, an eager group of Year 8 students gather to start a learning adventure.

Some love to write. Others aspire to be lawyers and scientists. Today, they're challenged to unleash their creativity and produce something magical; a wildly original, deeply personal, radio poetry play.

Thanks to wonderful sponsors like you, they're taking part in SmArts.

This innovative out-of-school program helps students grow their confidence and develop valuable skills. Writing. Teamwork. Creative thinking. And problem solving.

It also gives them crucial insights into what an arts career might offer, just as they're considering elective subjects for Year 9.

Access to innovative programs like SmArts is one of the many life-changing ways your sponsorship helps students. This kind of mentoring gives Australian children the chance to dream big for their future – and develop the skills and contacts they need to pursue it.

Immersed in creativity

Over four days, the students visit recording studios, learn about podcasts and radio, and explore types of poetry. Then, they develop an entire radio play. With zombies.

"Students get to discover things about themselves that never had the chance to come out before. They get to see how great they really are," says Phil, from our program partner Story Factory.

Their teacher agrees:

"My students are from a low socio-economic area. Being able to learn experientially, with mentors they would never otherwise meet, has **given them** skills that will serve them for years to come."

How sponsorship helped Declan soar



We've been following *Learning for Life* student Declan's progress for some years now. You may remember him from previous updates.

Now 13, he's settled in well at high school. And if you ask him what subject he likes doing best, he'll struggle to choose.

Science. Indonesian. Art. Sports. English. He's a confident all-rounder.

But turn the clock back five years ...

In 2020, everything was different. Declan, who has dyslexia, "struggled to read even basic words," says his mum, Cassie. "He was in Year 3 but only reading at Grade 1 level. He was very low in confidence."

Then Covid-19 sent schools into lockdown, and learning got even harder.

"I was struggling to even cover groceries and petrol, so we couldn't afford an internet connection," says Cassie.

The turning point

Then someone amazing, just like you, became Declan's sponsor.

"Our lives changed dramatically," says Cassie. "Through his sponsorship, Declan got free wi-fi, which made a massive difference. And the financial support really helped with shoes and uniforms."

But it was access to extra learning support that made the most difference.

Thanks to his sponsor, Declan joined our innovative student2student program. He was paired with a reading buddy, who called him twice a week to listen to him read and help him sound out hard words.

Declan fell in love with reading – and saw all his hard work pay off.

"I went from D to A in English", he beams. "I'm so proud of that."

"It's amazing to see how far he's come," says Cassie. "He's gone up six reading grades since he started student2student, and it's helped him do better in all his subjects."

Declan now has his sights set on a career in construction. (Or better yet, professional footy!)

A Learning Club with a difference

Every week, university student Alana spends two joyful hours volunteering as a tutor at her local Learning Club.

Thanks to sponsors like you, students at our after-school Learning Clubs receive personalised learning support to catch up and keep up with their schoolwork. While most Learning Clubs focus on homework support – with 84% of participants reporting it helps them do better in class1 – Alana's takes a more practical approach.

"We teach through cooking," Alana explains. "Reading recipes develops students' literacy skills and measuring ingredients helps them understand concepts like volume and weight."

Alana has a very personal reason for volunteering. "I grew up in a low-income family," she says. "A lot of things had to go right for me to achieve academically. I feel privileged to give back to less fortunate kids. Especially when I see the difference it makes."

"There was one girl who was really shy, but she's now one of the liveliest kids in the group," Alana adds. "One session, she took the role of teacher, having me spell out different words, then writing them down. She really enjoyed that!"
