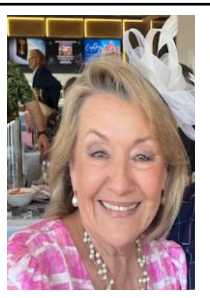
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

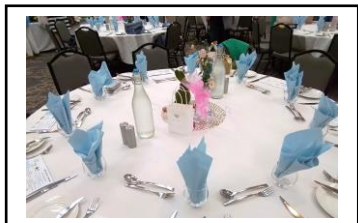
