To be unique is a gift you see; to be you is the best way to be.

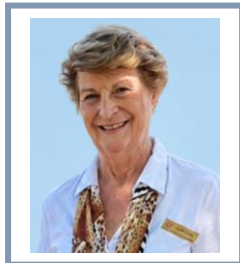

Karen joined Arana VIEW Club in 2022 as Assistant Secretary (Correspondence).

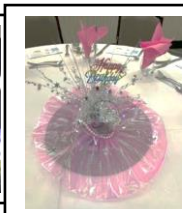
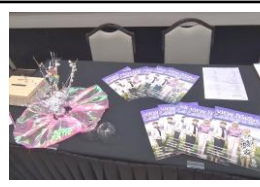

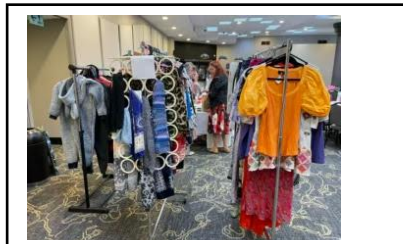
