Robyn, as the Coordinator for the North Coast, plays a crucial role in organising the delivery to schools of the Love Bites program, which the Club subsidises, including the training of facilitators.

'Love Bites is a Respectful Relationships Education Program for young people aged 15-17. It consists of two interactive workshops, Relationship Violence and Sex and Relationships, followed by creative workshops and community campaigns. 


