A friend tells a story of growing up in poverty. One day, she and her sister were told to take out their gran’s bin and to sweep the slabbed back yard.

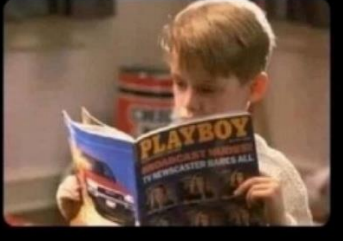

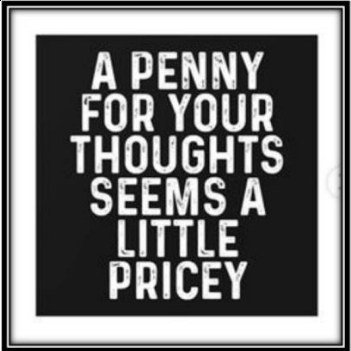




This was nothing unusual, so they got on with it, and they sang as they worked. When they were finished, their grandad gave them some (scarce) coins.
