INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

The United Nations' Theme for 2025 International Women's Day is "For ALL women and girls: Rights. Equality. Empowerment."

In Australia the theme is "March Forward: For ALL Women and Girls and The Campaign for 2025 is Accelerate Action

On Friday 7 March in Brisbane the celebration will be held in the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre—tickets start at \$189 for member/concession to \$3,990 for a Premium Table—any one going?

The Official date for International Women's Day is 8 March which was converted from 23 February in the Julian calendar to 8 March in the Gregorian calendar. The first **Women's Day** was held on 28 February 1909 in New York City and was organised by the Socialist Party of America.

On March 19, 1911 the first **International Women's Day** was when women throughout Austria-Hungary, Denmark, Germany and Switzerland amounting to over 1 million people paraded and protested against employment sex discrimination.

By 1913 America was celebrating "Woman's Day" on the last Sunday in February while Russia observed "International Women's Day" on the last Saturday in February which, converted to Gregorian calendar was actually 8 March.

In 1917 on 8 March [Julian 23 February] women textile worker's began a demonstration that eventually engulfed the whole city of Petrograd and marked the beginning of the *Russian Revolution*.

In 1922 Vladimir Lenin declared March 8 as International Women's Day to honour the women's role in the 1917 Russian Revolution. **The United Nations promoted International Women's Day in 1977**.

Australia first observed International Women's Day on 25 March 1928. with a rally in Sydney Domain [Held by the Militant Women's Group of the Communist Party]. IWD marches happened in Sydney and Melbourne in 1931. Perth followed in 1938.
