#### **DELEGATE'S REPORT – Colleen**

Some interesting statistics:

- 1.2 million Australian children and young people are living in poverty today.
- Nationally 178,430 disadvantaged children and young people received support through The Smith Family programs last year
- 67,165 Australian students were supported nationally through Learning for Life sponsorships

#### **Learning for Life Program:**

- 85% of LFL students are engaged in employment, training or education 2 and 1/2 years after leaving school
- Primary school aged students are at 85% school attendance
- 66% LFL students advance from Year 10 to completing Year 12

#### Student2Student:

- 96% of children in the Student2student reading program improved their reading age last year
- SmARTS program sponsored by Disney and facilitated by The Smith Family a 3-5 day workshop to work with secondary school students in musical theatre or art

150 VIEW members from 13 SA VIEW clubs volunteered as Traffic Marshalls at the Tour Down Under to earn \$11,000 for The Smith Family.
