ORDER OF AUSTRALIA MEDAL - OAM


Congratulations to **Judy Whiting** (Tea Tree Gully and Golden Grove VIEW Member) on being awarded the Order of Australia Medal (OAM) on 26 January for her service to lawn bowls.

Judy was a long-standing member of Modbury Bowling Club since the 1970s, and served a stint as President between 1989-91. This led to higher honours, taking the reigns of her State as Bowls SA President in 1995, the same year she was awarded Life Membership.

Judy has been a member of the SA Indoor Bias Bowls Association for over 45 years.
