# **RECIPE BOOK**

Thank you Pauline and Kay for putting together our Golden Grove VIEW Cookbook. Our thanks to those who contributed with some delicious recipes as well. Some copies are still available for sale at \$5 each.

One of the recipes included in the Cookbook is **lemon butter**.

*Ingredients:* 

4 eggs, beaten 4 large lemons 500gms sugar 125gms butter



Grate rind of lemons and squeeze the juice.
Place the butter and sugar in a double saucepan.
When melted, add the juice and grated rind of lemons.
Then add eggs.
Stir until smooth and thickened – about 20 minutes.
Bottle and seal.
