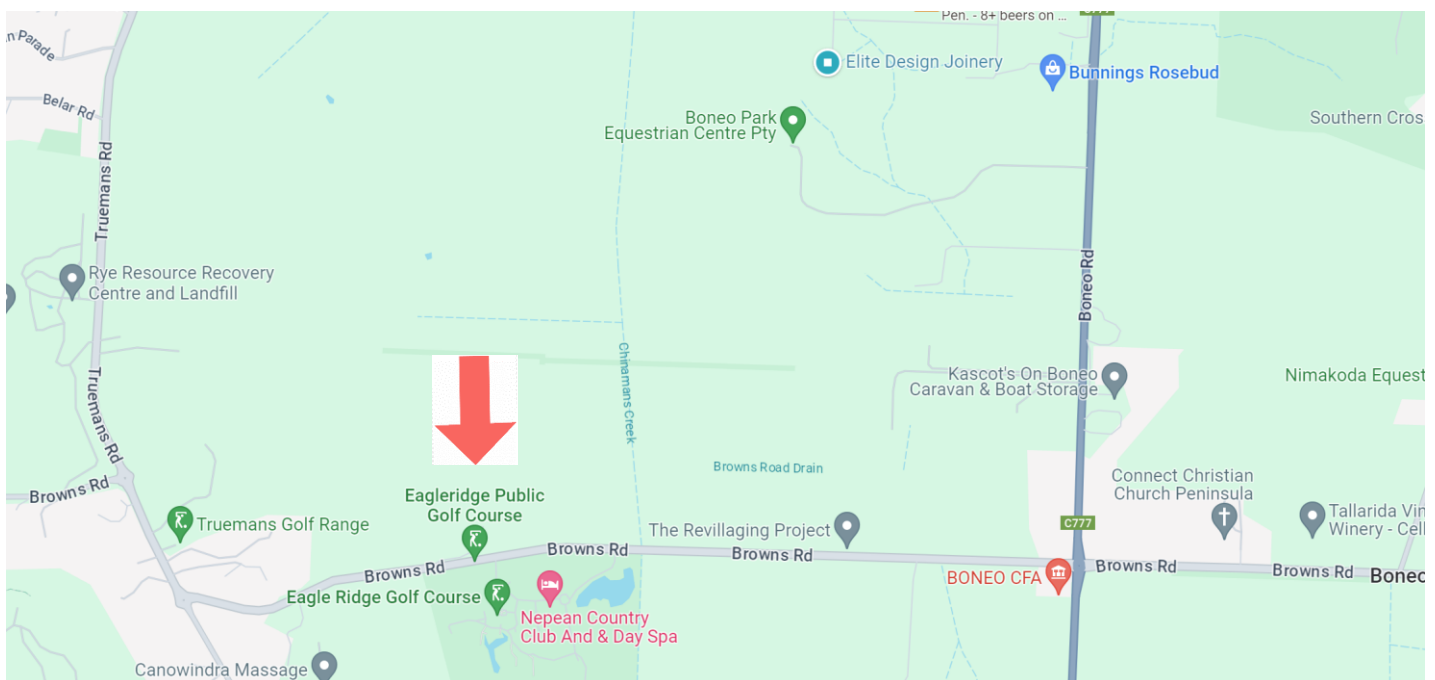

Trading Table

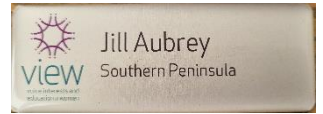


There will be a Trading Table one for the Annual General Meeting in February 2024.
