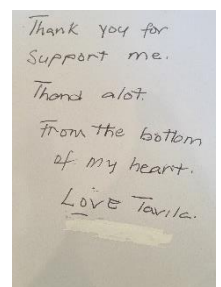
CLUB NEWS

Some VIEW news from The National Leadership Team (new name). There are 14 National Councillors and 26 Zone Councillors serving a new 2 year term. There are now 1725 LFL students being sponsored by VIEW clubs and 5 new clubs have opened. Our club has donated around \$5000 worth of Digital Learning packages which support LFL students by providing them with the digital tools and resources they need for school. VIEW clubs have donated \$254,000 in total to this program.

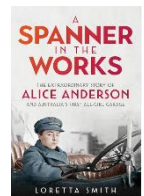

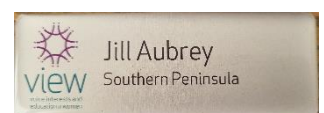
Trading Table
