Session 2 May 7th Glue the rope to your pot.

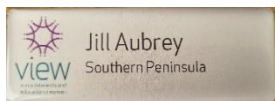

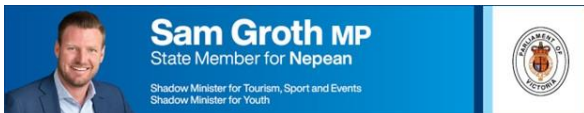
