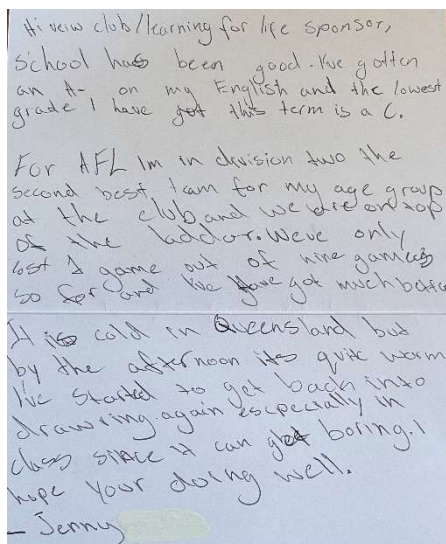

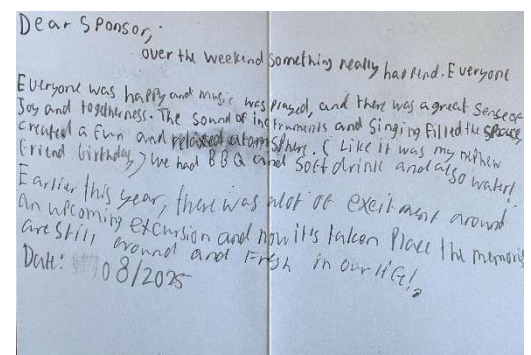
Learning for Life Program –Naomi & Jeanette

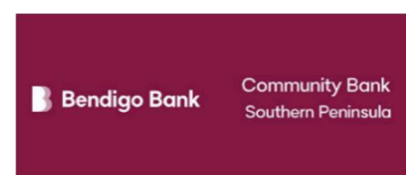
