### **Delegate's Report**

The result of the **Geographical Boundaries Review** for Area VB is to move Springvale VIEW Club from VB01 to VB02. The makeup of the Delegates meetings for VB01 and 02 is therefore unchanged except that Southern Peninsula is in VB01 and Springvale is in VB02. The purpose of the review was to encourage members to step up to Zone Councillor and National Councillor roles and distribute the geographical boundaries more sensibly without adversely impacting any clubs.
