1980	The Australian Women's Weekly, selected The Smith Family, through VIEW Clubs to be the beneficiaries of Jumbly 1980. \$53,540 was raised
1981	The Jumbly Fair was arranged for a second year. \$43,000 was raised
1982	\$2.75 million donated to The Smith Family by VIEW Clubs over 12 years.
1983	First Victorian club Doncaster VIEW Club was formed on 7 January 1983, with the Inaugural Luncheon on 10 December 1983
1984	4 more clubs formed in Victoria.
1985	National Council meets monthly – previously met every four to six weeks. Section A of Resolutions regarding V.I.E.W. Constitution withdrawn from the Convention format.
1986 –	First Queensland club – Surfers Paradise.
1987	First Certificates of Appreciation awarded for increased membership to Orange 1st Dingley 2nd.
1988	Combined seminar held during November for all Zone Councillors – Review of National Council to give equity for all members currently Zone Councillors from Sydney or outer suburban areas could attend National Council.
1989	Meetings and Seminars held during throughout the year in preparation for the introduction of Areas in the VIEW organisation to commence in 1990.
