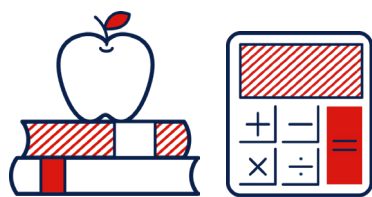
The fact is, poverty isn't always visible, yet it can be right there in front of you. Its impact on education is unfair, and can be relentless and devastating.
