The Call Out

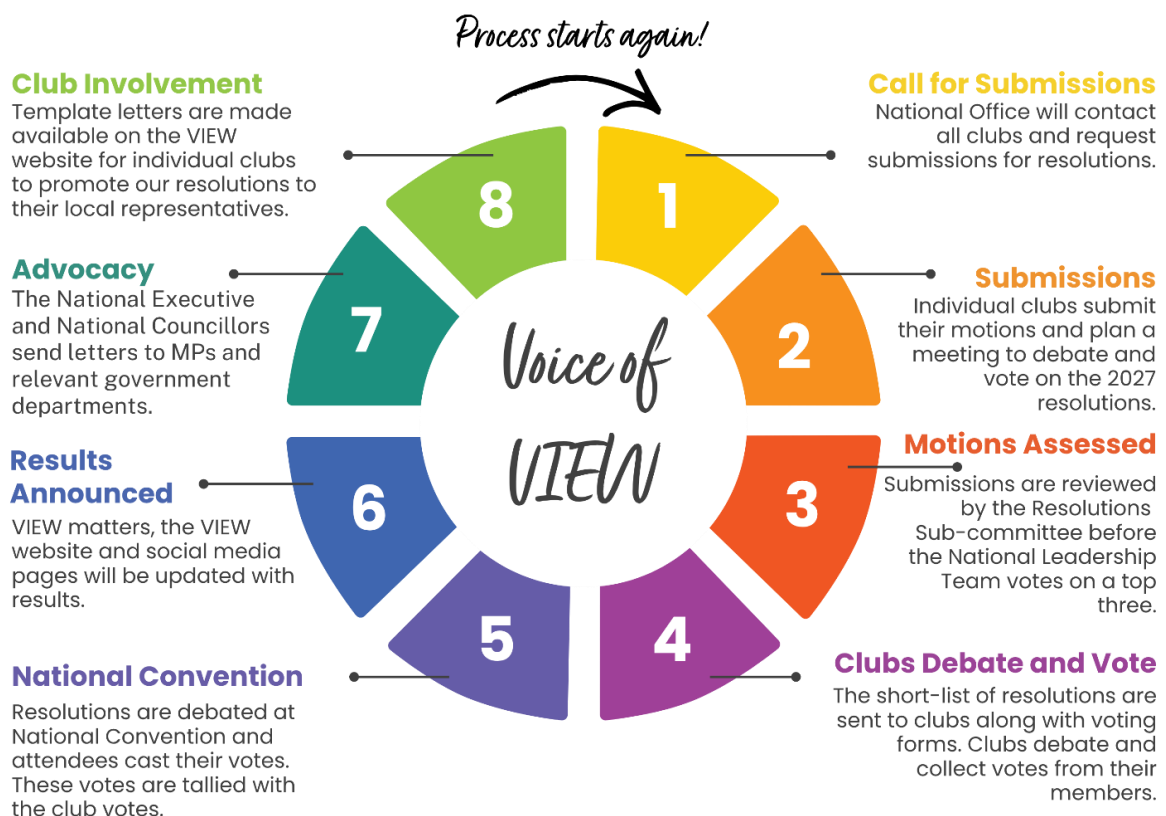


Every two years, VIEW members vote on one or more issues of importance that will be the focus of advocacy and lobbying work for the coming years. Through the VIEW National Resolution process members are able to collectively identify and articulate issues that are considered important for influencing social change in Australia.

Resolutions provide a platform promote not only issues of importance, but also the work of VIEW and The Smith Family supporting the education of Australian children experiencing disadvantage.

VIEW dedicate one resolution to Education, Children or the interests of Women. Many of these resolutions have related to current topical issues such as an equitable education for all children, or domestic violence. These issues are ongoing and impactful challenges in our society and have formed part of our advocacy platform multiple times over the years.

VIEW Clubs are now invited to...

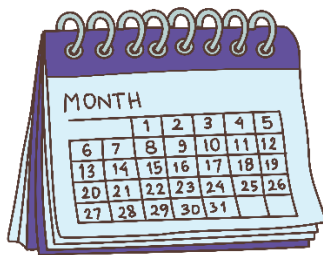
Discuss with their club members and committee issues of national importance that you believe VIEW should be advocating for and submit your suggested topics for consideration using the online form.

What should resolutions cover?

- National Issues:** VIEW is a Locally Focused while Nationally Active organisation. Each individual club may have local issues in their own community that they care about and contribute to. The Voice of VIEW is a national platform that focuses on issues of national significance.
- Aligned with our Mission and Vision:** Our Vision is “Women creating and leading a more inclusive Australian society”. Our Mission is “As a leading voice and valued support network for women, VIEW actively raises awareness of, and participates in, the work of The Smith Family”
- Current and topical:** Issues that are of interest to the broader community and relevant to today’s society. We often have the same resolutions pop up again and again over the years – some issues are long standing and advocacy is ongoing.
