



What is Money Talks?

Money Talks is a Vocational Education & Training (VET) certified program for students in Years 10–12 which helps you make better informed financial decisions. Students who demonstrate competency in all assessable activities have the opportunity to gain a nationally recognized qualification, namely a “Certificate I in Basic Financial Literacy – FNS10120”.

Course content

The course covers 6 topic areas or unit. Assessments accompany each unit

- Developing a knowledge of the Australian financial system and markets
- Develop and use personal budgets
- Develop and use saving plans
- Develop knowledge of debt and consumer credit
- Develop knowledge of taxation
- Develop knowledge of superannuation

What do I need to complete my enrolment?

- ✓ Are you 15 years or older? You can register for this course **online**. You'll need to provide your parent/caregiver's **email address OR their mobile number**. If you can't supply their email address nor mobile number, you'll need to obtain a **paper Registration & Consent form from your teacher and get your parent to sign it**
- ✓ Are you younger than 15 years? You'll need to obtain a **paper Registration & Consent form from your teacher and get your parent to sign it**
