



UNLEASH YOUR STUDENTS' CREATIVITY





The Smith Family's SmArts Creative Enrichment program provides students an opportunity to use their imagination, engage their creative skills and learn more about creative industries. Each program connects students with creative professionals, provides a hands-on creative experience and offers a behind the scenes look at creative industries in the real world.

WHO: Years 8 to 12. Eligible students must demonstrate an interest in and/or talent for the creative arts. Programs are capped to 20 students.

WHAT: SmArts offers a range of focused programs such as theatre and drama, visual arts, dance, music, media, and storytelling.

WHEN: The program can be delivered at any time throughout the school year. However, timing is subject to the availability of our creative partner organisation.

WHERE: The program may be delivered at your school or at our creative partner organisations location.

SmArts programs run for a minimum of 20 hours with artists/educators from a creative organisation delivering 70 to 80% of the creative practice sessions. The Smith Family also partners with universities and other community organisations to support components of the SmArts program.

The program is led by facilitators provided by our external creative partners. However, teacher supervision is required.

The Smith Family will provide:

- Our creative partner organisation to run and facilitate the program
- Access to creative professionals for industry talks, Q&A panels or webinars
- Arrange a relevant excursion to an arts related organisation
- Further information and resources to the creative arts following the conclusion of the program.
